Bishop William J. Barber II

A legendary civil rights activist and pioneer of American social justice organizing, Bishop William J. Barber is Co-Chair of the Poor People's Campaign and Founding Director of Yale Divinity School's Center for Public Theology and Public Policy. His unyielding leadership has lifted barriers for people of color, women, poor people, and people with disabilities at a national level for decades, and in his home state of South Carolina. Bishop Barber also formerly led as Mel King Fellow at MIT, was president of the South Carolina chapter of the NAACP until 2017, and was a board member of the National NAACP until 2020.



Gloria Steinem

Gloria Steinem is a writer, lecturer, political activist, and feminist organizer whose decades of critical leadership has invited new analysis on the shared origins of sex and race caste systems, gender roles and child abuse as roots of violence, non-violent conflict resolution, the cultures of indigenous peoples, and organizing across boundaries for peace and justice. Gloria Steinem is a VISIONS Advisory Board member.
